The Treasurer discussed the FY2012 Cash Flow Analysis through May looking at revenue, outstanding revenue and realistic expenditures in non "salary and benefit" areas for the month of June. Mr. Snell informed the Treasurer, Mr. Arledge, that the Board was only willing to offer a Two-Year Contract, instead of the Five-Year Contract he is eligible to receive and had requested, sighting the financial issues in Ohio Education and the uncertain future of Educational Service Centers in Ohio.

After much discussion...

It was moved by Mrs. Brooks, and seconded by Mrs. Wiseman, that the Board approve offering the Treasurer a Three-Year Contract, effective August 1, 2012 – July 31, 2015, keeping all items in the current contract as they have been previously approved.

Vote: Mr. Snell, aye; Mrs. Wiseman, aye; Dr. Frank, aye; Dr. Gallagher, aye; Mrs. Brooks, aye. Motion carried.
